Martin Wallace – Reflections on Tasmanian Economic Policy and Other Matters



Join the Tasmanian Branch of the Economic Society of Australia for the Annual General Meeting at the Astor Grill, featuring a talk from Martin Wallace. Non-members are welcome, with AGM formalities kept to a minimum.

Martin Wallace is a former Secretary of the Department of Treasury and Finance. In a diverse public sector career spanning from the mid-1970s until his retirement in 2013, Martin held senior executive roles in Treasury, Energy, Telecommunications and Health and Human Services in Tasmania. In his early public sector career, Martin held policy analysis and research roles in the Department of Premier and Cabinet, the Department of Industrial Development and the Australian Bureau of Statistics. He was also chief of staff to Treasurer, Dr David Crean, between 1998 and 2012.

Over the period of his career, Martin was close to many of the major economic issues faced, and the policy decisions made, by successive governments. He will reflect on the impact of key economic decisions and issues, and will share personal insights from his experiences.
