### *“Structural Change in Australian Industry: the Role of Business Services”*

*Over time, there have been significant changes to the way goods and services are produced and delivered in the Australian economy. This has led to changes in industry economic activity and to the relationship between the industries. Supply chains are getting longer and business services are becoming increasingly integrated with other industries. At the same time, the nature of business services is evolving quite quickly and the skills required by the business services sector are changing significantly. Understanding these changes is important background for interpreting economic developments using industry data.*
